The Past Year Results

- Includes 2 week forecast from 6/11/21 to 6/30/21
- Donations were 92% of spending plan
- Limited Annual Session expenses due to pandemic
- Other expenses overall lower:
 - Reduced travel expenses.
 - Low youth program expenses.
 - Offset by new expense, employee benefits annual premium
- Estimated cash flows are about a positive \$1,700

The Past Year Results — Bal. Sheet & Inc. State.

- Values in Spending Plan include projections from 6/11/21 to 6/30/21
- Assets
 - Cash increased ~\$1,000 from 1 year ago
 - Mutual funds increased \$17,700. NB: These can go down as well as up.
- Liabilities: Still none
- New Income Statement features:
 - Employee benefits premium expense for Group Life and Long Term Disability. SCYMF pays 100% up front to limit policy fees.
 - Member meetings reimburse about a third of this over June 2021 through April 2022 as income to SCYMF. This was established at Feb Qtr Meeting.

Proposed Spending Plan – Jul 2021 to Jun 2022

- Keep most items roughly the same
 - Slight increase in donations and interest
 - Besides Annual Session Registration, most expense levels are the same.
- Introduce new line items for new benefits program
- About \$12K of next Canby Grove Meeting (July 2022) has already been paid. But Annual Session is usually self supporting. We can either:
 - Keep registration fees at usual levels,
 - Let the accumulated pre-payments reduce annual session fees once, or
 - Do something halfway in between.
 - This plan takes the intermediate route.
- Work with Coordinating Committee to refine estimates and finalize Spending Plan by September Quarterly Meeting.
